**LGIA Spring/Summer/Fall 2010 work quotes**

Quotes must be submitted to a Board member on or before 7:00 P.M. on Thursday March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2010  
Any quotes received after the above date and time will not be considered.

Item 1: Weekly cleaning and raking of Battistoni Beach on each Friday, Saturday, and Sunday of each week [before 10:00 A.M.] including raking the entire beach each of the three days, removing and disposing off-site of rubbish, weeds, twigs, branches, leaves, and other incidental debris from the beach and parking area each of the three days, removing and disposing off-site of animal droppings from the entire beach area each of the three days including all labor, equipment and incidentals thereto at a total weekly cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for each three days [Friday, Saturday, and Sunday] of weekly cleaning and raking of Battistoni Beach as specified herein, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board [rate will be prorated for days when inclement weather does not allow cleaning].

Item 2: Weekly cleaning and raking of Moore Beach on each Friday, Saturday, and Sunday of each week [before 10:00 A.M.] including raking the entire beach each of the three days, removing and disposing off-site of rubbish, weeds, twigs, branches, leaves, and other incidental debris from the beach and parking area each of the three days, removing and disposing off-site of animal droppings from the entire beach area each of the three days including all labor, equipment and incidentals thereto at a total weekly cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for each three days [Friday, Saturday, and Sunday] of weekly cleaning and raking of Moore Beach as specified herein, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board [rate will be prorated for days when inclement weather does not allow cleaning].

Item 3: Weekly cleaning and raking of Children's Beach on each Friday, Saturday, and Sunday of each week [before 10:00 A.M.] including raking the entire beach each of the three days, removing and disposing off-site of rubbish, weeds, twigs, branches, leaves, and other incidental debris from the beach and parking area each of the three days, removing and disposing off-site of animal droppings from the entire beach area each of the three days including all labor, equipment and incidentals thereto at a total weekly cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for each three days [Friday, Saturday, and Sunday] of weekly cleaning and raking of Children's Beach as specified herein, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board [rate will be prorated for days when inclement weather does not allow cleaning].

Item 4: Mowing and trimming [not before 8:00 A.M.] the adjacent dam areas on a seven (7) day to fourteen (14) day interval so grass does not exceed five (5") inches in height, removing and disposing off-site of rubbish, weeds, twigs, branches, leaves, and other incidental debris from the grass area prior to each mowing, removing and disposing off-site of animal droppings from the grass area each prior to each mowing including all labor, equipment, materials, fuel, oil, and incidentals thereto at a total cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for each mowing and trimming of the adjacent dam areas as specified herein, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board.

Item 5: Mowing and trimming [not before 8:00 A.M.] the adjacent areas of Children's Beach on a seven (7) day to fourteen (14) day interval so grass does not exceed five (5") inches in height, removing and disposing off-site of rubbish, weeds, twigs, branches, leaves, and other incidental debris from the grass area prior to each mowing, removing and disposing off-site of animal droppings from the grass area each prior to each mowing including all labor, equipment, fuel, oil, materials, and incidentals thereto at a total cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for each mowing and trimming of the adjacent areas of Children's Beach as specified herein, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board.

Item 6: Periodic mowing and trimming [not before 8:00 A.M.] the adjacent areas of Moore Beach to Lake Street and the adjacent parking area on a seven (7) day to fourteen (14) day interval so grass does not exceed five (5")

inches in height, removing and disposing off-site of rubbish, weeds, twigs, branches, leaves, and other incidental debris from the grass area prior to each mowing, removing and disposing off-site of animal droppings from the grass area each prior to each mowing including all labor, equipment, fuel, oil, materials, and incidentals thereto at a total cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for each mowing and trimming of the adjacent areas of Children's Beach as specified herein, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board.

Item 7: Periodic mowing and trimming [not before 8:00 A.M.] the adjacent areas of Battistoni Beach to Lake Street including the adjacent parking area and extending approximately fifty (50') feet to the north on a seven (7) day to fourteen (14) day interval so grass does not exceed five (5") inches in height, removing and disposing off-site of rubbish, weeds, twigs, branches, leaves, and other incidental debris from the grass area prior to each mowing, removing and disposing off-site of animal droppings from the grass area each prior to each mowing including all labor, equipment, fuel, oil, materials, and incidentals thereto at a total cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for each mowing and trimming of the adjacent areas of Children's Beach as specified herein, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board.

Item 8: **Annual one-time clean-up during March or April lake drawdown period** for all areas listed in Items 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 listed above and including raking [power or hand/manual] of each area and removing and disposing off-site of rubbish, weeds, twigs, branches, leaves,, vegetation, animal droppings, and other incidental debris from each of the areas [grass, beach, and parking areas listed in items 1. through 7.] including all labor, equipment, fuel, oil, materials, and incidentals thereto at a total cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for the annual clean-up as specified herein, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board.

Item 9: Brush cutting, clearing, and trimming the area on the west side of the dam between the fences and the waterline of the lake adjacent to the gate valve chamber on a requested basis [possibly twice a year], removing and disposing off-site of vegetation, rubbish, weeds, twigs, branches, leaves, and other incidental debris from the area including all labor, equipment, fuel, oil, materials, and incidentals thereto at a total cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for brush cutting, clearing, and trimming of the areas as specified herein, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board.

Item 10: Brush cutting, clearing and trimming the area in the spillway downstream of the dam extending from the dam to the outflow pipe for the lake and between the east and west fences along the sides of the spillway on a requested basis [possibly twice a year], removing and disposing off-site of vegetation, rubbish, weeds, twigs, branches, leaves, and other incidental debris from the area including all labor, equipment, fuel, oil, materials, and incidentals thereto at a total cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for brush cutting, clearing, and trimming of the areas as specified herein, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board.

Item 11: Hourly rate for providing various additional work [brush cutting and removal, raking and clearing paths, debris removal and disposing off-site, painting, patching pot holes, etc.] including all labor, equipment, fuel, oil, materials, and incidentals thereto at a total hourly rate of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for each hour of work requested, specified, approved, and accepted by the LGIA Board. This hourly rate is applicable for the following types of work [vendor/individual should circle types of work listed below and/or fill-in on the lines provided the types of work the hourly rate will be applicable for]: brush cutting and removal; raking and clearing paths; debris removal

and disposing off-site; Painting; patching pot holes; or

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It should be noted that the cost of materials associated with the above work listed in item 7. such as paint, stain, asphalt, wood, etc. [if approved by LGIA] will be reimbursed upon submittal of a paid receipt.
